Associate: Includes voting privileges, but not eligible to hold office. Not licensed as a professional engineer in Kansas or Missouri (may be licensed elsewhere), possessing a bachelor's degree in structural, civil, or architectural engineering.

Retired: No voting privileges and not eligible to hold office. Qualified for one of the above grades, except no longer actively practicing, and possesses at least 25 years of structural engineering experience.

Student: No voting privileges, and not eligible to hold office. Enrolled in full-time degree program in structural, civil, or architectural engineering, intending to engage in professional practice of structural engineering after graduation, and permanent residence or educational institution is located in Kansas or Missouri.

Affiliate: No voting privileges and not eligible to hold office. Not qualified for any of the above membership grades.
